

# Configuring CakeHR

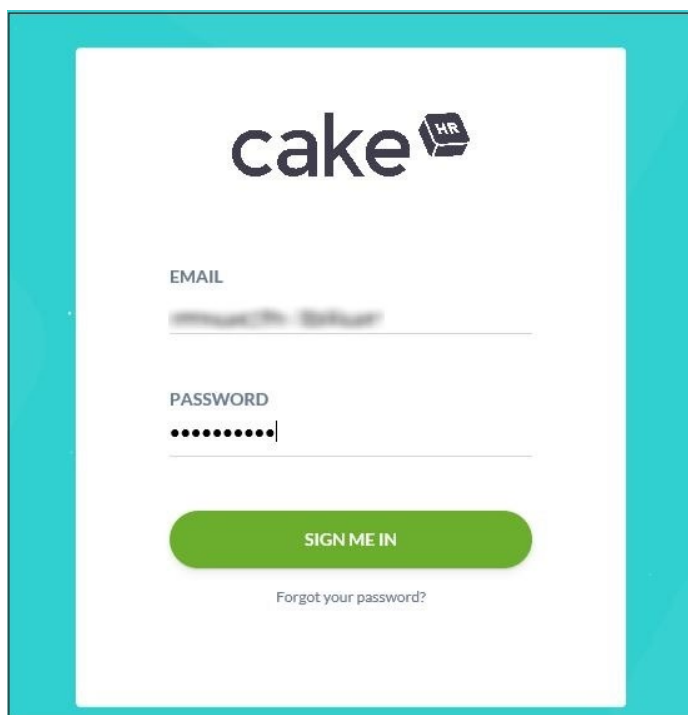
Configure CakeHR for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to CakeHR by using the enterprise credentials.

## Prerequisite

Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above

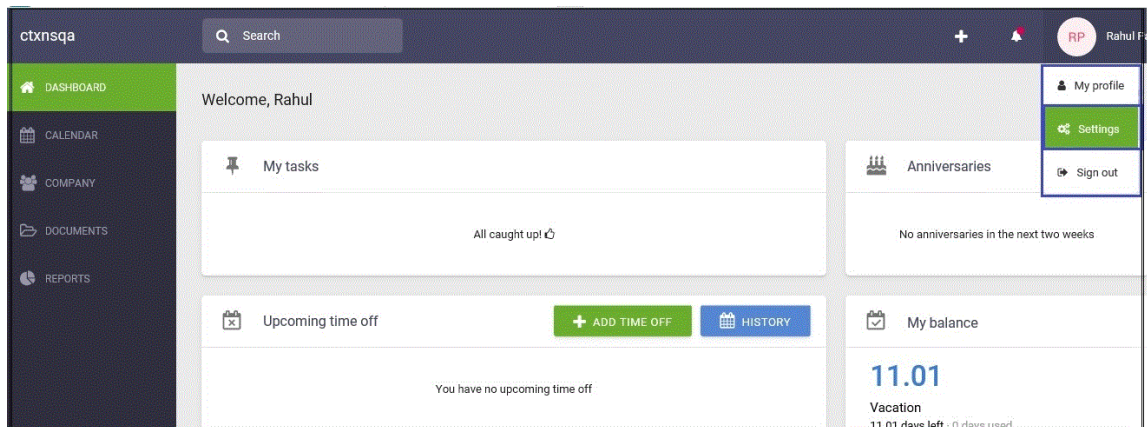
## To configure CakeHR for SSO by using SAML:

1. In a browser, type <https://cake.hr>, and press **Enter**.
2. Type your CakeHR admin account credentials (**EMAIL** and **PASSWORD**) and click **SIGN ME IN**.

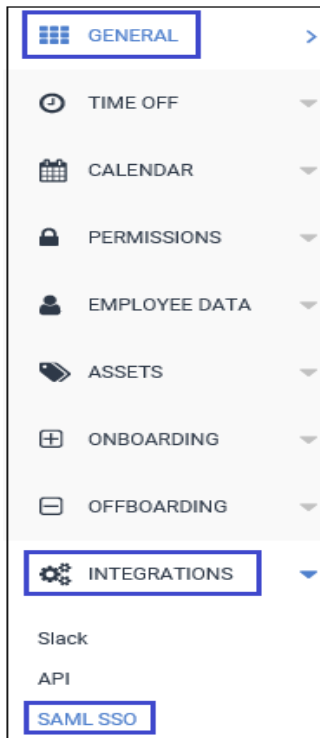

4. In the left panel, navigate to **General > Integrations**, and select **SAML SSO**.



- In the **SAML SSO** section, enter the values for the following fields:

| Authentication URL | IdP logon URL   |
| Key Fingerprint    | Copy and paste the IdP certificate fingerprint from the <a href="https://www.samltool.com/fingerprint.php">https://www.samltool.com/fingerprint.php</a> link, select <b>Algorithm</b> and <b>Generate the Fingerprint</b> . |
