

# Configuring Nuclino

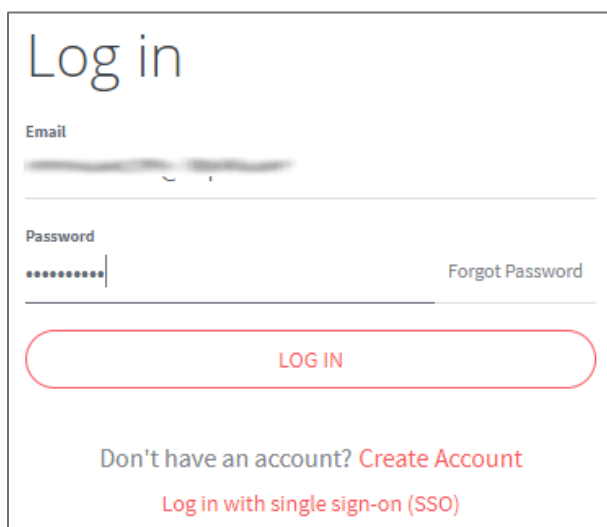
Configuring Nuclino for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to Nuclino by using the enterprise credentials.

## Prerequisite

Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above

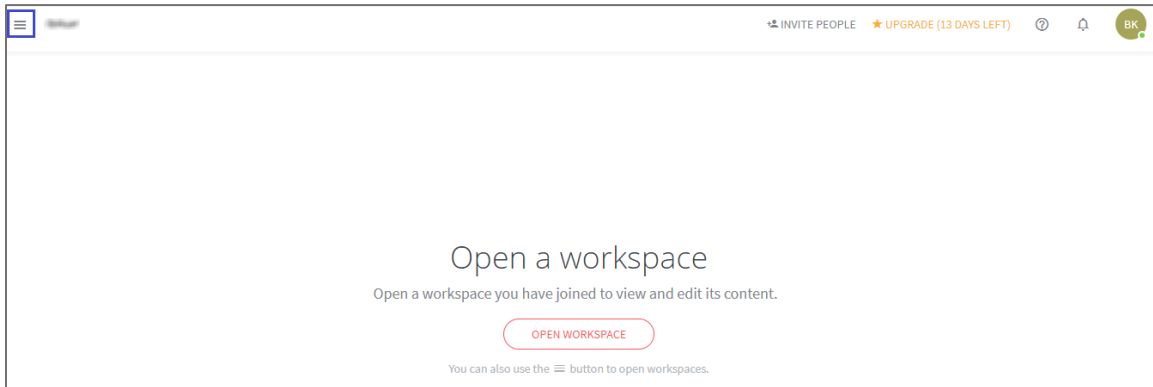
## To configure Nuclino for SSO by using SAML:

1. In a browser, type <https://app.nuclino.com/login> and press **Enter**.
2. Type your Nuclino admin account credentials (**Email** and **Password**) and click **LOG IN**.

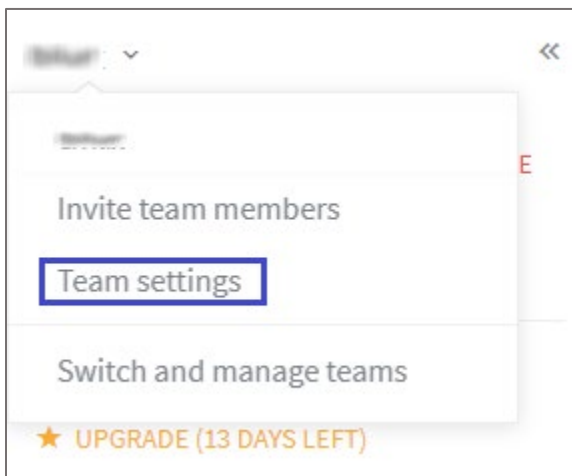

4. Click the workspace name and select **Team settings** from the drop-down list.



5. In the **Team settings** page, scroll down and select the **SAML-based single sign-on (SSO)** option under **Authentication**.

6. Enter the values for the following fields:

Field Name	Description
SSO URL	IdP logon URL
Entity ID	IdP entity ID
Public certificate	Copy and paste the IdP certificate. <b>Note:</b> The IdP Certificate is provided by Citrix and can be accessed from the link below: <a href="https://ssb4.mgmt.netscalergatewaydev.net/idp/saml/templatetest/idp_metadata.xml">https://ssb4.mgmt.netscalergatewaydev.net/idp/saml/templatetest/idp_metadata.xml</a>
